

Call for Composer – Shape Shifters

We are looking for a **composer** to join the creative team of *Shape Shifters* – a joyful, visually striking new performance for early years audiences (ages 3+), blending contemporary dance, visual storytelling, and quick-change illusion to explore identity, diversity, and self-expression.

Produced by the **Edinburgh International Magic Festival**, *Shape Shifters* is a collaboration between choreographer **Eszter Marsalko**, costume designer **Alison Brown**, and director **Svetlana McMahon**, with creative support from North Edinburgh Arts.

Who We're Looking For

We're seeking a composer who is:

- Able to compose and produce approximately 45 minutes of original music for playback on a standard PA system
- Excited by interdisciplinary collaboration (especially with dance, costume, and visual design)
- Confident working with non-verbal and narrative-driven performance
- Sensitive to early years audiences and the emotional/sensory journey of young children
- Able to create playful, textured, emotionally rich soundscapes

Experience working on early years productions is welcomed but not essential. We're open to a range of styles as long as it's grounded in sensitivity, imagination, and a willingness to explore.

Project Details

Rehearsals (R&D):

- 27 October 9 November 2025
- Composer is not required to attend daily but will be invited to visit rehearsals, observe the creative process, and respond to the developing material
- Reference tracks or temporary mood music will be provided during R&D to help guide tone and texture

Tech & Performance:

• 15–20 December 2025 (tech week and two work-in-progress performances at North Edinburgh Arts as part of MagicFest)

• Final compositions to be delivered in advance of or during the tech week for playback on a standard PA system

Location:

• Edinburgh-based preferred for in-person sessions, but hybrid/remote working is possible

Fee

- £2,000 fixed fee
- Includes all composing, editing, and delivery of final audio for performance
- Travel costs may be covered if agreed in advance
